

The teams were given 15 minutes to cook a nutritious meal.


Azmina's team made cheesy chicken pasta and Asma's team made chickpea curry with a fruit salad.

This was a day full of D.T and computing. We had the privilege to use microbits. As you pass Nimesha, remember to say thank you for letting us use these micro-bits.


